



### Project Information

- The Burnie Cam Pipeline Project is part of a program of network upgrades that Cradle Mountain Water is currently undertaking.
- The Burnie Cam Pipeline Project will provide rationalisation of the Burnie Water Supply Network and the Cam Water Supply Network via a new link between the two networks.
- The project will allow Cradle Mountain Water to retire the Cam Water Treatment Plant and Pumping Station, provide greater utilisation of the Burnie Water Treatment Plant and provide energy savings by using gravity to deliver water to deliver water to the Cam Network.
- Cradle Mountain Water has engaged GHD to undertake the design and documentation phases of the project.
- During June and July 2011 GHD and their sub-consultants will be undertaking a range of surveys and investigations in the corridor proposed for the pipeline.
- The surveys will involve a number of visual assessments for environmental and heritage surveys as well as the digging of a small number of test pits for geotechnical investigations.
- In a very small number of cases the alignment crosses private property, and in these instances property owners have been contacted directly. For other people living in the area it is not anticipated that the works will impact you and there will be no disruption of services or traffic in the area as a result of the work.
