Re: Cradle Mountain Water Welcomes New Chairman

Cradle Mountain Water has welcomed today's appointment of Mr Miles Hampton as the new Chairman for the Tasmanian Water & Sewerage Corporations replacing the outgoing Chairman Mr Geoff Willis.
