



### Fast Facts

- \$2.6M project initiated by Devonport City Council to provide security of waste water disposal pumping to the Pardoe Treatment Plant.
- The existing pump station is the last link in the pumping chain and failure of the station would cause significant environmental damage to the foreshore.

### Construction consists of:

- A new diversion pump station electrical drive and controls.
- A new odour treatment facility accepting sewerage gases from both the new pump station and the existing.
- The treatment facility will accept all product gases and remove odours before releasing them to the atmosphere.
- An emergency generator to be installed to come on line in the event of a power failure at the site, thus providing surety of effluent disposal.
- Refurbishment of the existing pump station walls, pumps and electrical drives.
